Who is qualified to register?

If you possess the prerequisites skills, then register is open on a first come, first serve basis?



How many seats are available?

18



Will we work in groups?

Yes, you will work in three groups, in a team of 6.



Program Questions (Cont.)



Why are your group sizes so big?

Maintaining a group size of six ensures the team can continue operating effectively if one or more members need to transfer or withdraw from the program. This structure helps minimize disruption and prevents a significant impact on overall productivity and caseload.



Will we have to sign an NDA?

Yes, an NDA must be signed prior to the start of the first day of the program.



When will we find out the name of the client?

Within 5-10 minutes after registration



Do you offer refunds if I am no longer able to attend?

No, we have a strict no refund policy. If you cannot attend, we will transfer you to a later program.



Will this result in a job?

No. This program is designed to provide real, on-the-job experience and develop practical data analyst skills using SQL and Excel workflows for weekly reporting.

Participants will work with real data and real reporting processes, gaining experience that closely mirrors what analysts do in the workplace. This allows you to add meaningful, hands-on experience to your resume and position yourself more competitively in the job market.



How often do you offer this program?

Program Questions (Cont.)



Is this a remote program?

Yes, 100% remote.



Can we have a job while participating in the program?

Yes — approximately 85% of our previous participants were employed full-time while completing the program.



When will our weekly meetings with our program manager take place?

Participants will meet one to two times per week during weeknights starting week 3.



How is this different compared to you're a regular boot camp?

This program is fundamentally different from our current BI boot camps because it is designed to simulate real, on-the-job analyst work rather than classroom-style instruction.

Our SQL boot camps focus on teaching concepts, building foundational skills, and practicing through structured exercises and guided datasets. This program, however, centers on applying those skills in a real work environment with real expectations and deliverables.

Key differences include:

- Work with live client data instead of practice or simulated datasets
- Contribute to actual business reporting needs, not classroom exercises
- Deliver professional outputs such as Excel reporting
- Participate in resume and portfolio development tied directly to your work
- Experience a workflow that mirrors what data analysts do on the job



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
